Technical Session/Wine Doctor

We all shared and tasted Beausoleil's initial Tidal Bay entry during the business meeting and it now was the first wine that Melanie tested. The grapes used were 37% l'Acadie, 32% Chardonnay, 17% Geisenheim and 14% NY Muscat. pH3.2, TA 7.5 and 50 ppm SO2, very much perfect values.

P. Jucker brought his 2024 l'Acadie. It showed TA 8.6 and 5 ppm SO2. Melanie showed Peter how he now can raise sulphite to the desired 50 ppm.

Every member brought a bottle of their wine for analysis and Melanie measured and then offered suggestions on corrections that could be made.

It was a very good meeting, the last of the season and the President thanked Melanie for hosting us and being very generous with her time.
